

Video Encoding Cheat Sheet

Note that this sheet is just meant as a quick reference guide and not a comprehensive tutorial. The full tutorial that accompanies this sheet can be found at <http://pi.vu/B2aV>

1. [MakeMKV](#) – initial rip.
 - a. Scan the disk.
 - b. (If your beta key has expired, see <http://pi.vu/B2aa>)
 - c. Select only the biggest chapter for a film, or all (to be safe) for a TV series. Uncheck any foreign language subtitle / audio tracks you don't want.
 - d. Rip.
2. Subtitles (if your video has them.)
 - a. [MKVExtract](#) (from [MKVToolnix](#) suite)
 - i. Extract all subtitle tracks.
 - ii. Check for small sup / sub file.
 - b. If foreign language file found, then [Subtitle Edit](#)
 - i. Load the relevant sup / sub file
 - ii. "Start OCR", provide corrections as needed
 - iii. Save as srt file.
3. [Handbrake](#)
 - a. Load the original MKV file.
 - b. Select MKV as container format, and select file destination.
 - c. Go to subtitles tab and add the srt file produced earlier. **Make sure the "default" checkbox is checked for this subtitle track.**
 - d. Go to the audio tab, select "Auto passthru" on the codec dropdown box to preserve surround sound.
 - e. Go to the video tab, change "Constant Quality" slider to 19.
 - f. Drag "x264 preset" slider to "VerySlow".
 - g. Double check everything, and then hit start.
